2. If there is a difference in the names of the parents in the records of high school. Inter mediate and graduation level, the candidate will fill the admission application from only after rectifying that error from the concerned office.

Terms of Entry

1. Good discipline is essential in the college. If is a co-educational institution. Therefore, on admission and other necessary, only parents can come and contact the principal / head of department and solve their problems. Other outsiders can contact them only after obtaining permission from the principal. Thereby it will be mandatory for him to take written permission from the obtained in-charge at the inquiry center and enter his details on the visitor's register.
2. It is mandatory for every trainee to keep the identity card with him at all times and present it when asked by the invigilators. Disciplinary for not presenting the identity card.
3. With a view to eliminate the feeling of high & low among the trainees, dress code is prescribed in the college. Under this, the trainees are required to wear the dress prescribed by principal / head of the department.
4. It is essential for all the trainees to study in their class regularly. 90% attendance has been made mandatory by the university. Trainees with less than 90% attendance will not be allowed to appear in the university examination.

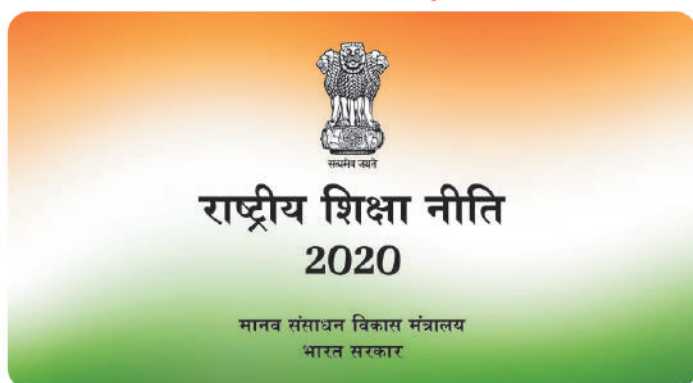
